

Disability Services:

- Any student has the right to self-disclose or can choose not to do so under the ADA laws. The building has handicapped accessible parking and restrooms.

Request for Reasonable Accommodations:

- The Academy Admissions Director has been designated to handle inquiries regarding non-discrimination policies and services for disabilities, including intellectual disabilities. It is the student's responsibility to inform the admissions department of any desired special services so that reasonable accommodations may be taken into consideration.
- A Request for Reasonable Accommodations Form will be distributed to every student prior to enrollment in which the students may self-identify disabilities, including intellectual disabilities.
- Individuals with disabilities are afforded an equal opportunity to participate in The Academy's programs and activities, along with equal employment opportunities in the industry, but note that The Academy and future potential employers may only be required to make reasonable modifications or accommodations for such individuals, as required by law.
